"Financing, design, construction and operation of a customs and logistics complex in the At-Bashy district of the Naryn region"

General information

Description of the project

This project involves the construction of a customs terminal and customs-related infrastructure near the "Torugart" checkpoint. The goal of the project is to improve state functions for customs clearance and customs control of goods, as well as to develop economic growth and foreign economic relations in the region. It is expected that the construction of a customs and logistics complex using public-private partnership mechanisms will contribute to the improvement of control systems, modernization of customs administration, customs inspection, post-customs control, and will also lead to an increase in the efficiency and quality of trade logistics and logistics services. In addition, the implementation of this project will increase the throughput of the customs terminal, which will increase the flow of goods, and the availability of an effective border customs infrastructure will always be an important factor in accessing markets outside the region, as well as expanding trade with regional and international partners.

1. Customs

- customs clearance functions;

- the customs post;
- checkpoint;
- administrative buildings;
- covered overpass for customs inspection.

2. Commercial

- transportation services;
- certification bodies;
- warehouses (dry, cold, chemical, biological, radioactive);
- parking of freight automatic telephone exchanges;
- forwarding companies;
- Banking services;
- catering points;
- office buildings.

State contribution:

Provision of a state land plot with an area of 24 hectares

Private partner obligations:

A single complex with an area of 24 hectares including related services and infrastructure
