Description of the project

This project involves the construction of a customs terminal and customs-related infrastructure near the "Torugart" checkpoint. The goal of the project is to improve state functions for customs clearance and customs control of goods, as well as to develop economic growth and foreign economic relations in the region. It is expected that the construction of a customs and logistics complex using public-private partnership mechanisms will contribute to the improvement of control modernization of customs administration. inspection, post-customs control, and will also lead to an increase in the efficiency and quality of trade logistics and logistics services. In addition, the implementation of this project will increase the throughput of the customs terminal, which will increase the flow of goods, and the availability of an effective border customs infrastructure will always be an important factor in accessing markets outside the region, as well as expanding trade with regional and international partners.
